



Guidelines for authors

Form:

- Please use the .doc / .docx or .pdf format to submit your abstract. You can generate a PDF at acrobat.com after a brief registration for free. Any other format will be rejected.
- The primary email address for submission is: **office@cimt.eu**.
If for some reason this does not work for you then send your abstract to:
abstract@cimtmainz.org
- The abstract must not exceed one page!
- Use the following font for text: Arial, 11 pt. and single line spacing.
- Greek and other special characters may be included. If you are unable to reproduce a particular special character, please type out the name of the symbol in full. Please double check all your special characters before submitting. If Word is giving you trouble: The PDF format will do a better job in preserving your symbols than Word.
- SI Units should be used throughout (litre and molar are permitted, however)

Content:

- All abstracts are to be in English. Spelling must be US English or British English, but not a mixture.
- The title should be in bold with no full stop at the end.
- Abbreviations should be used as sparingly as possible. They should be defined when first used.
- Author names should be in regular font, as first name and surname with no full stop. Author names should be separated by a comma. Where authors are from a number of different institutions, the appropriate institution number from the affiliation list should be given as a superscript number immediately after each author's name, e.g.:
Michael Nesheim, John Samis², John Walker³ etc.
If the authors are presenting an abstract on behalf of a study group, this information should not be included in the author list, but should appear in an acknowledgements section.
- Affiliations are to be in italic, and should include department, institute, town and country. Where there are multiple affiliations, each should be listed as a separate paragraph. Each institute should appear in the same order that is used with the author names (see above paragraph) and show the according superscript number, e.g.:
1 Department of Biochemistry, Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario, K7L 3N6, Canada
2 Department of Pathology, Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario, K7L 3N6, Canada
3 Organon Teknika Corporation, Durham, NC 27712, USA
